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Dalla homepage: Il Gruppo di Ricerca “Nicolaus Heinsius” (HUM 261) dell’Università di Huelva è composto da un team internazionale di ricerca impegnato in una edizione critica e in un commentario del testo delle Metamorfosi e delle opere minori di Ovidio. Questo lavoro è stato sviluppato attraverso l’Excellence Research Project HUM-1019 “Ovid’s Metamorphoses” (2006-2009) della Junta de Andalucía e attualmente attraverso due progetti di ricerca: Consolidated Project FFI2008-01843 “Ovidian: critical edition and textual commentary of Ovid’s Metamorphoses” (2009-2013) of the Spanish Government, e Excellence Project HUM-4534 “Critical edition of Ovid’s Metamorphoses and Opera minora” (2010-2013), della Junta de Andalucía. Il suo obiettivo è, da un lato, pubblicare una nuova editio maior e il primo commentario critico delle Metamorfosi di Ovidio. L’editio maior propone una nuova collazione completa dei manoscritti esistenti e delle edizioni. Il commentario critico è eminentemente testuale: esso differisce dai precedenti (e. g., Bommer, 1969-1986) e da quelli in corso (e. g., Fondazione Lorenzo Valla, 2005 & sq.). Il nostro gruppo, d’altro lato, realizzerà per la Bibliotheca Teubneriana l’edizione critica di: Ibis, Nux, Consolatio ad Liuiam, Epistula Sapphus e Halieutica, e gli Scholia in Ibin, con una rinnovata e completa collazione di tutti i manoscritti ed edizioni. Inoltre, intendiamo comunicare alla comunità scientifica internazionale gli obiettivi e i risultati del nostro progetto attraverso la pubblicazione in riviste internazionali. Infine, è nostra intenzione creare, a medio termine, il “Nicolaus Heinsius Research Institute”, dedicato all’edizione e al commentario critico di testi letterari di diversi periodi e ambiti culturali.

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
